ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES

ILR Secretarial Services: Office service to breed associations that may include a complete management service or most any parts thereof. ILR is currently providing such services with the International Livestock Registries (ILR) General Stud and Herd Book, the Composite Beef Cattle herdbook, the International Dairy Cattle Registry, for the American Lineback Cattle Association, the Homestead Cattle Association, the Heritage Shorthorn Society, the U.S. Normande Breeders Organization, the North American Pinzgauer Association, and the International Stockhorse Association.

Custom Reports. Customized reports can be developed at cost based on any information in our computer.

Data Transfer. Data in the ILR computer can be transferred electronically for use at breed association offices.

Breed Association Inquiries. Responding to telephone inquiries and letters.

Administration Policies Objective assistance with reviewing by-laws, ethics, rules or policies.

Fees Received. Deposit fees received from membership, breeders and other breed associations in registry account.

Herd Books. Customized herd or stud books can be printed on request.

Mass Mailings. Mass mailings to members or non-members.

Memberships. Maintaining an up-to-date membership list. Issue membership cards for all new members and renewals. Lists, statistics and mailing labels printed for current, new or lapsed members, membership renewal notices. Mailing labels can be sorted by postal code, name, or in accordance with USPS for 1st or 2nd class mail. In the case of associations with multiple breeds, lists, statistics and mailing labels are available for specific studbooks, herdbooks or breeds.

Parentage Verification / Genotyping DNA Tests. Notices of required parentage test including blood vials can be mailed.

Certificate Duplicates. Copies of certificates can be sent to member or to the breed association office.

Animal ID (Tattoos, Brands, Eartags, Microchips, etc.) ILR contracted eartags, microchips are usually available at cost. Lists of association registered herd prefixes, tattoo letters sorted by breeder name or tattoo letters are available.

Transfer Notices. Notices of all transfer of ownership and leases can be sent to the breed association office.

Printing Design and printing of application forms, regulations, fee schedules, certificates, receipts and membership cards, unusual requests can be printed at additional cost.

Form Distribution. Form distribution as requested by breeders. Mass distribution of forms is at an additional cost.

Permanent Storage of Documents. Every application of registration, transfer, all documentation of traits & genetics, correspondence, is kept in readily available storage for a period between 1--2 years and thereafter is negotiable. It is always permanently available digitally.

Overdue Accounts. Interest is charged on overdue breeder accounts.

By-Laws. Maintaining an up-to-date copy of each breed association by-laws.

Association Product Distribution. Distribution of contracted products including tattoo equipment, ear tags; Destron Fearing Ear Tags, RFID Tags. Distribution of AVID microchips, readers and syringes. DNA testing through our contract labs including Neogen, Etalon, etc.

Publishing. Production of forms, newsletters, catalogs, brochures, business cards and logos, etc., including design, printing and mailing. Word processing and spreadsheets are also available.

DATABASE QUERIES

Progeny Lists. Lists of progeny are available to breed associations and individual breeders (covering one generation or all generations of descendants).]

REGISTRATION SERVICES

Applications. Verifying applications in accordance with breed association rules, policies and by-laws.

Animal ID Register. Maintaining a register of tattoo letters, herd names, herd prefixes, breeder prefixes and brands. Issue receipts as new combinations are received & registered.

Animal Registrations. Printing permanent (or provisional or temporary as needed) registration certificates for animals or embryos with a properly completed application with payment. Certs can also be electronically transmitted. Maintaining a pedigree database.

Complete All-Breed Pedigrees. Research, Across-Breed Identification, completion &/or correction of pedigree discrepancies between ROP, associations & registries.

Animal Transfers. Recording changes of ownership of registered animals and embryos.

Animal Leases. Recording leases & end of leases of registered animals.

Fees Charged. Charging the fees for services provided to individual breeder accounts as specified in the breed association fee schedule.

Account Statements. Printing an up-to-date statement each time a breeder submits work or fees. This statement provides a complete breakdown of transactions in each breeder's account.

Correction of Errors. Corresponding with breeders to correct errors on applications in order to avoid unnecessary delays and additional costs.

Animal Listing. Pedigrees can be selected and sorted by several criteria and printed as a report.

Export Duplicate. Copies of certificates for export animals can be sent directly to a foreign association or the breed office.

Extended Pedigrees. Pedigrees showing up to six (6) generations of ancestry can be provided for use by the breed associations or individual breeders. In addition, a printout of all ancestry for an animal in the computer is available regardless of the number of generations.

Herd Inventories. Lists of animals owned or sold by a breeder can be printed.

Semen Certificates. Semen certificates can be issued to track the registration of animals resulting from artificial insemination.

Semen Transfers. Semen ownership records can be maintained.

Stallion Reports. Maintaining a record of services listed on stallion reports to track registration of offspring.

Record of Performance (EPDs or ROP) Data. Performance data is printed on certificates. Identification and correction of pedigree discrepancies between ROP and registry.

Electronic Data Transfers. Between ILR and: association offices, genotyping labs, regional, national and international genetic centers, magazine publishers, breeders, etc.

Electronic Herd Book. Member, breeder and pedigree information may be posted in each association's section of the ILR website.

Fully Integrated Database. ILR offers a fully integrated database including both registration, pedigree, breeder, genetic and performance information.

Weekly Reports—Animal ID information, breeder & herd information, breeder & member receipts, changes in breeder information, deposit totals.

Monthly Reports—Transaction statistics, membership statistics, fee breakdown, Accounts Receivable, Import/Export Statistics, Tax Reports.

Annual Reports—Detailed registration breakdown by breeder, detailed registration breakdown by sex, location, and breed, listing of breeder accounts, annual reports and financial statements.
